

GIRVAN NORTH PARISH CHURCH, 16th April, 2013.

At Girvan Parish Church, on the Sixteenth Day of April, Two Thousand and Thirteen Years, the Presbytery of Ayr met and was constituted in prayer.

309. SEDERUNT. Rev A Symington, Moderator, and others as per Sederunt Sheets in rententis. Ministers, 12; Elders, 18; Total 30. Apologies were received from 5 Ministers and 4 Elders and were similarly recorded. 4 others were associated with the Presbytery.

310. INDUCTION OF THE REV RICHARD MOFFAT TO GIRVAN: NORTH.

All relevant matters being in order and the Clerk having laid on the Table the prescribed Edict duly executed, no one having appeared to object to the life or doctrine of the said Rev Richard Moffat, the Presbytery resolved to proceed to the Induction of the Rev Richard Moffat to the Pastoral Charge of Girvan: North. Public Worship was conducted by the Rev John Matthews, Minister emeritus Glasgow: Ruchill Kelvinside, who preached a sermon appropriate to the occasion. The Narrative and Preamble having been delivered and the prescribed Questions asked and answered satisfactorily, the Rev Richard Moffat signed the Formula.

The Moderator, with prayer, did induct the Rev Richard Moffat and admit him to the Pastoral Charge of Girvan: North. With other Presbyters, the Moderator gave him the Right Hand of Fellowship. Thereafter, the Moderator put to the Congregation the required Questions which were answered satisfactorily, and gave the Charges.

Public Worship being concluded, the Presbytery instructed the Clerk to confirm the Rev Richard Moffat's name on the Roll of the Presbytery and inform all interested parties. Those taking part were thanked and the Sederunt was closed with prayer.
